“Try-Outs” (Skills day) will be held on Sunday February 17th at 9:00 am for rookies & minors and 10:00 am for Majors 60 & 70. You can mail the completed registration form with the fees to **PO Box 848, Ocean Park, WA 98640**. Or drop off at OP elementary, LB elementary, Hilltop School, & Boys & Girls Club. The registration deadline is **February 15, 2019**
Forms must be received **before** try-outs.

As a general guideline, 5-6 yr. olds play T-ball, 7-8 year olds play coach pitch Rookie, 9-10 yr. olds play Minors, 10-12 yr. olds play Majors-60, and 11-12 yr. olds play Majors-70. However, final team placement will depend on the player’s ability. Softball has U10 for 2nd & 3rd graders, U12 for 4th, 5th & 6th graders, & U14 for 7th & 8th graders. Baseball practices will start after March 1st, while games will generally start after April 1st with rookies starting a couple weeks after older teams. Softball season begins after April 1st. T-ball practices/games will start in June.

We will be having a 50/50 raffle at Spring Sports Ceremonies to which the date is to be decided!

Try-Outs are mandatory for any kid outside of T-Ball

Softball is available for girls in 2nd grade through 8th and will have a skills day at a later date

**Try-Outs, for baseball, rain or shine, will be held:
February 17, 2019 @ 9:00 am & 10:00 am**

If you don’t show, you don’t play.
